- ▶ Brief CVs for each tutorial lecturer (no more than 300 words per person).
- ▶ Importance and timeliness of the tutorial.
- ▶ Previous lecture and tutorial experience of the tutorial speaker(s).

Please consider strategies to accommodate the tutorial delivery in case of a virtual conference format.
